

## Declaration of consent to carry out a rapid antigen test ("self-test") at school from 2 August 2021 onwards

Persons are now only allowed to enter the school if they have a negative test for the SARS-CoV-2 virus that is not older than 24 hours. This testing by means of recognised self-tests can, among other things, be carried out at school under the supervision of teachers (Section 1a para. 1 sentence 2 no. 1 School Corona Ordinance).

If the test result is positive, the school is obliged in accordance with Article 6 (1)(c), Article 9 (2)(i) of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) in conjunction with Sections 6 and 8 of the Infection Protection Act (IfSG) to inform you about your positive test result or the positive result of your child and to forward your data or the data of your child (name, date of birth and health data) to the responsible health authority. This is necessary to be able to identify you/your child correctly and to contact you if necessary.

I am aware that the test obligation can also be fulfilled with the alternatives mentioned in Section 1a of the 3rd School Corona Ordinance (testing at the test centre and presentation of the certificate; testing at a recognised test centre and presentation of the certificate or testing by means of a recognised test in the home and presentation of the corresponding certificate).

With my signature, I consent to my child taking the self-test at school. In this context, I consent to the processing of my personal data or those of my child in connection with the self-testing. I am informed that if I am tested in class, the result of my child's/my self-test could be disclosed to the third parties present.

Revocation of this declaration of consent for testing at school is possible at any time with effect for the future (by post, e-mail or fax to the school).
